Guidelines for Mall Locations

1. Mall music will be turned down a little during performances; however the mall's retailers are allowed to have their music set at a certain level. **Please DO NOT contact individual retailers to turn down their music.**
2. **NO microphones or amplifiers are allowed.**
3. **NO signs are allowed.**
4. **NO soliciting.** This includes requests for donations, distribution of pamphlets or flyers, membership drives or other related activity. (You may distribute a printed program for your students and families in attendance. Please make sure you pick up any programs that are left lying around before the next teacher begins.)
5. **The mall is not responsible for lost or stolen items.**
6. As your students gather for their performance, **please be courteous to the teacher and students who are performing.**
7. **Do NOT leave the piano unattended.** Please wait until the next teacher arrives before leaving the area.
8. **Watch the time carefully and please stay within the time you were assigned for your recital.**
9. **Please pick up your student's participation ribbons.** They will be in a large envelope on the piano or on a chair close by. Hopefully the teacher before you will hand you the envelope.
